


INTERNATIONAL CONTEST OF YOUNG FASHION DESIGNERS



The candidates of the International Contest of Young Fashion Designers will be asked to reflect on a specific theme. They will have to imagine **3 outfits**, a ready-to-wear feminine outfit, a ready-to-wear masculine outfit, and a sophisticated outfit.

Then they will have to **send to Talons**Aiguilles their file, containing drawings, sketches, material samples. Following the evaluation of their applications, the association will select 20 finalists. These 20 candidates will then have to make their outfits from scratch and will have the chance to see them march during an evening in a prestigious place of the town of Lille.

On that day, we will host a jury that will evaluate the candidates' creations while discussing with them.

NEW THEME: ART AND FASHION

Art has a profound influence on fashion by inspiring diverse aesthetics through the adaptation of artistic patterns, colors, and shapes in clothing design.

Historical art movements have given rise to clothing styles, while collaborations between artists and designers result in the creation of unique pieces. Fashion shows have become true performances. The integration of artistic elements into outfits allows for individual expression, with artists transforming clothing into works of art.

Fashion and art intertwine to reflect cultural issues, and the combination of these two domains breaks norms to generate innovative and bold styles, thus creating a constant synergy between artistic creativity and the world of fashion.

That's why, for its XXXIst edition of the International Young Designer Competition, Talons Aiguilles has decided to highlight the creative harmony of art and fashion by choosing three key artistic works from our world.

THE CEILING OF THE OPERA GARNIER, CHAGALL:

The ceiling of the Opera Garnier, designed by Marc Chagall in 1964, merges modern aesthetics with the neo-baroque style of the Opera. The dreamlike composition depicts allegorical figures and lyrical motifs in vibrant colors, creating a dynamic fresco that evokes the world of opera and dance. This iconic ceiling transcends the boundaries between art and architecture, magnifying the Opera Garnier as an enchanting place of artistic contemplation.





THE WATER LILIES OF THE ORANGERIE MUSEUM, CLAUDE MONET:

"Claude Monet's Water Lilies" represent a captivating series of paintings created between 1914 and 1926. These iconic works, inspired by the water lily ponds of Giverny, demonstrate Monet's mastery in representing light, color, and changing nature. Taking a central place in the Orangerie Museum, each of these canvases offers a unique visual and emotional experience while anticipating modern art movements.

THE SUNFLOWERS, VAN GOGH

"The Sunflowers" is a series of paintings created by Vincent van Gogh during the late 19th century. These iconic works depict sunflowers in various stages of bloom, highlighting Van Gogh's passion for color and texture. The canvases reflect his quest to capture the vitality of nature through vibrant tones and expressive brushstrokes. ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICANTS:

There are two categories of applicants: <u>independent designers</u> and <u>fashion students</u>. The rules and theme apply to each category. Whatever the category, the applicant must be the designer and creator of his own outfits..

THE APPLICATION FILE:

The personal file must be made of:

- The registration form you will find at the end of this document filled and signed
- · Your résumé with a picture
- · A written interpretation of the theme
- A presentation of your school or professional path in a 50-words paragraph
- · A mood board
- · A range of colors
- · Sketches of outfits: sketch with colors, by hand or by computer but also flat cuts with some indications about the material you would use
- · Samples of fabric and for accessory or the jewelry
- · Evaluation on a scale of 1 to 10 of the level of difficulty and time required for an external dresser to put the outfit on a mannequin

We recommend you to add to the file your portfolio so that we can better understand your whole creativity.

Finalist files cannot be returned until the day of show because they are likely to be exposed.

THE OUTFITS:

In order to be selected for the Finale of the Contest, you will have to create **3 outfits** on the theme "The Art and Fashion", based on the given definition and your own interpretation.

- · A man's ready-to-wear outfit
- · A woman's ready-to-wear outfit
- A woman's sophisticated outfit for this outfit you should focus on the choice of the fabrics, their association, the details and the finishing touches.

These 3 outfits must be created in the spirit of a mini-collection, and must be harmonious in style, colors and materials.

Candidates are free to create some accessories.

MEASUREMENTS:

To design your silhouettes, you will retain the standard sizes of agency models:

- 90-60-90, between 1,78 and 1,85m for women
- · 100-80-100, 1,90m (more or less 5cm) for men

However, it is better (and really necessary) to provide wider than not enough (chest and lower body for women, bust and sleeve length for men...): there is always time to add pins at the last moment!

Models are professionals. You must not provide your own models.

THE ACCESSORIES PRIZE:

You will have the opportunity to exclusively compete for this unique prize, or to accumulate your entries and compete in both this one and the traditional prizes dedicated to outfit creation.

Registration for the Accessories Prize is by no means required to participate in the outfit competition; it is based on the voluntary participation of student and independent candidates.

This year, six finalists will be selected for the final round of this prize.

THE ACCESSORY FILE:

It must necessarily include the same elements as those mentioned earlier, of course with sketches of accessories and not outfits.

For candidates wishing to compete in both the Accessories Prize and the traditional prizes, only a color range, sketches of accessories, and material samples need to be provided in addition to the other elements already included in the outfit-specific portfolio.

THE ACCESORIES:

In order to be selected for the final of this prize, you must envision 3 accessories on the theme 'Art and Fashion,' considering the given definition and adding your personal interpretation as a mandatory requirement.

A 'head' accessory: hat, cap, headband, etc.

A 'neck' accessory: scarf, stole, scarf, etc.

A bag: handbag, backpack, satchel, etc.

(a more significant consideration is requested regarding the choice of materials, their combination, details, and finishes).

These 3 accessories should be harmonious in both style and colors and materials.

You will need to create them if you are selected for the final.

THE CSR AWARD:

The CSR price will reward the candidate who will have realized their outfits in a CSR approach: upcycling, 0 waste, made in France, animal welfare... The candidate will have to support the steps taken in their file and highlight the sustainable aspect of their outfits. This will complement the other elements required and mentioned for the composition of the file.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Compliance with all instructions given above will be taken into account in the pre-selection of the files as in the finale of the Competition.

Also involved are the **cleanliness** of the file, the technical quality of the sketches and outfits and / or accessories made, the originality of the creator as well as the general look of the outfits.
